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Tussar Silk Sarees

- Malda district of West Bengal is the hub of Tussar Silk production.
- Tussar Silk is more textured than the conventional silk and is also used as a base for weaving elaborate Jamdani or Baluchari.
- Pure Tussar Silk sarees are usually characterized by solid colours that are enhanced by a golden sheen of the silk, adorned with both traditional and contemporary motifs on the pallu.

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Men's Traditional Attire

- Traditional attire for men in Bengal usually consists of the dhoti.
- Dhotis are paired with a silk or cotton **Punjabi** or **kurti** – a loose fitting shirt which usually goes down to the knees.
- White and off-white are the traditional colours dhotis and Punjabis are worn in.
- Today's Bengali men may take their liberties with colours of their traditional attire.



Dhunuchi Naach



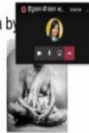
- This devotional dance is performed holding a dhunuchi, which contains the burning coconut husk with dhuno sprinkled on it.
- Dhuno, the Indian equivalent of frankincense, is a plant resin of sal tree, and dhunuchi is essentially an incense burner that holds the fire.

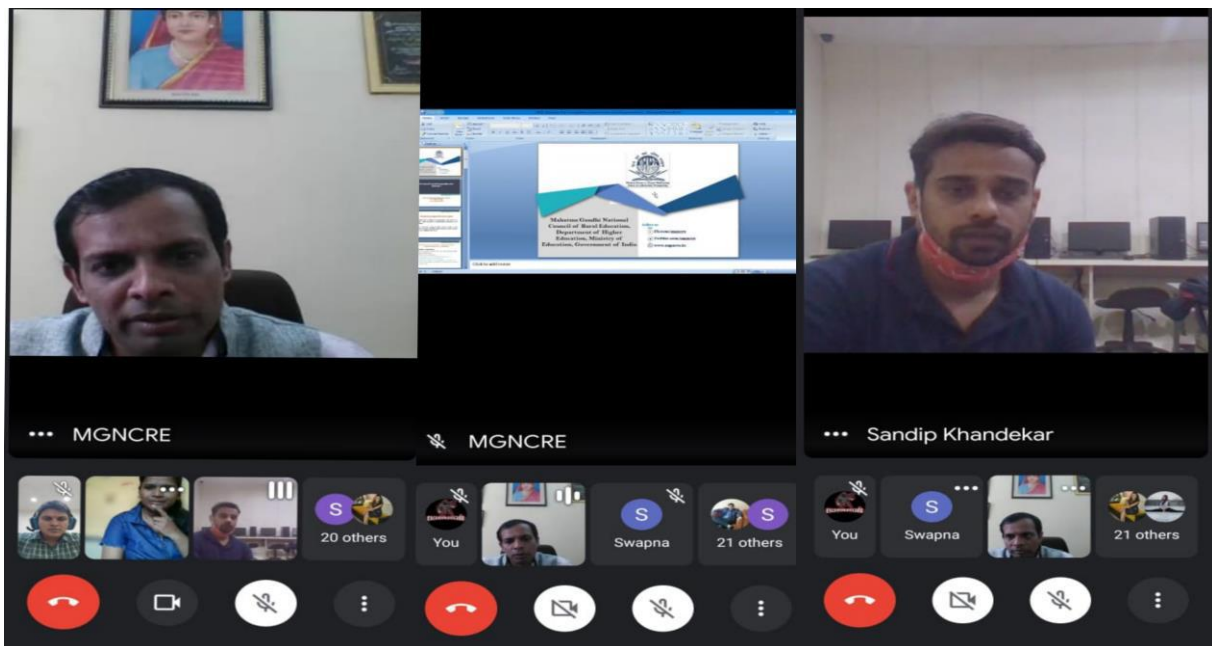
MGNCRE Workshop

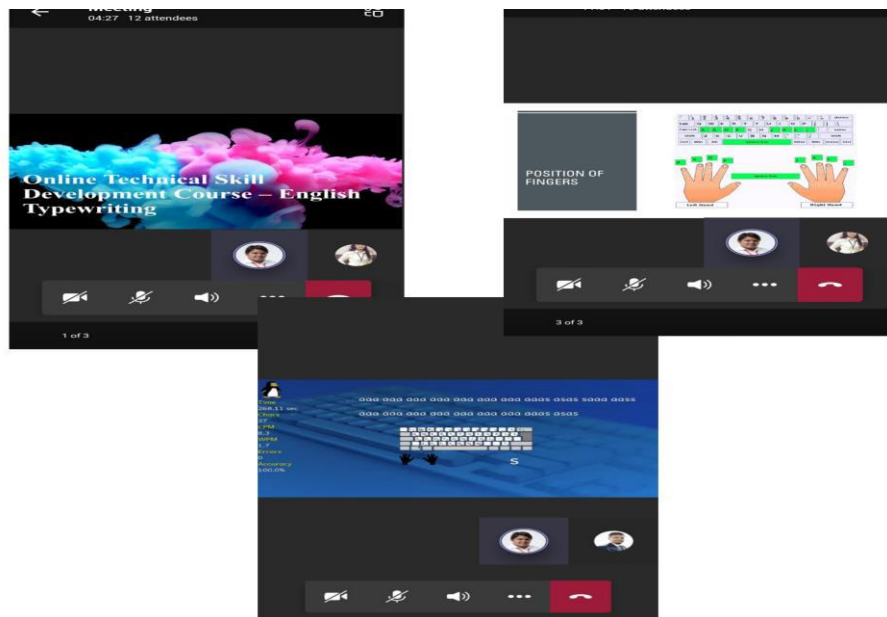

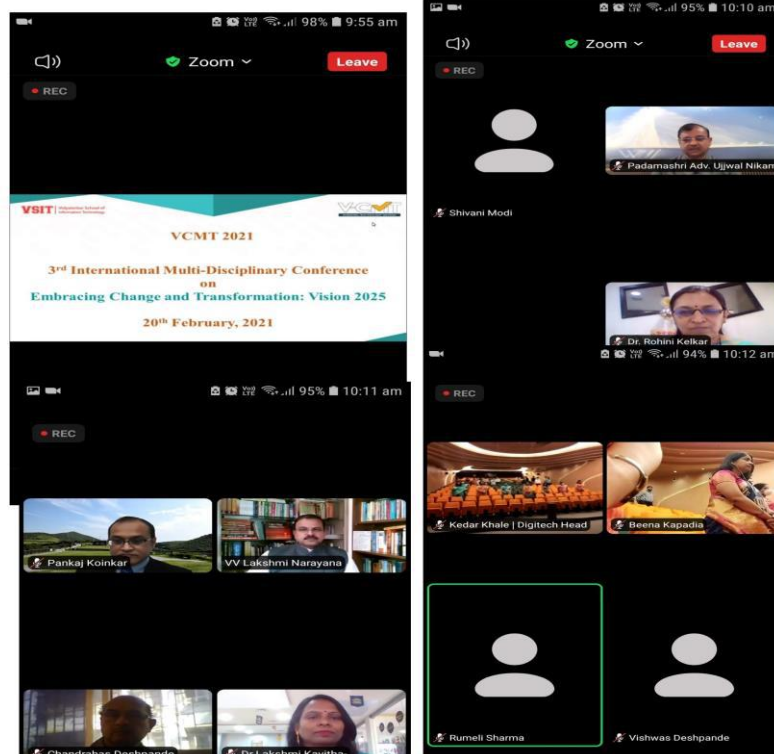
