Emphasis on procedural fairness has been given with a view to "the right to be heard and right to be treated without bias".

Functions

- To co-ordinate between students and Departments to redress the grievances.
- To guide ways and means to the students to redress their problems.

Students' Grievance Procedure

The grievance procedure is a gear to sort out the issues between students and college. It enables to express feelings/ approaches by initiating and pursuing the grievance procedure in accordance with the rules and regulations of the college. Matters are disclosed to only those, who have a legitimate role in resolving the matter.
