
















b) Counselling

Ms. Archana Samarth speaking on emotions and self-awareness for faculty and students








c) Common Room



03:00	Security Officer Satish Gode made an introduction speech bringing about various
	aspects of demonstration and fire mock drill. A brief idea about use of fire
0200	equipment and firefighting was given to all present there
0300	Prabhakar Janye undertook fire training and how to use all fire equipment in detail.
03:25	A brief was given to all members of Mock Drill. All are informed about their role.
03:45	Display boards "MOCK FIRE DRILL IN PROGRESS" AND "ASSEMBLY POINT" were
04:10	displayed on every floor of M block and assembly area.
04:10	A mock fire drill to be carried out as announced in advance. Mock fire drill was to
	be conducted at M block Canteen kitchen. An insane stick was lit and brought close
04.11	to smoke detector of kitchen. This started giving a fire alarm in the building.
04:11	M block Sec. Supervisor Gajendra Sharma on duty and present on 1 st floor of M
	Block building rushed to the FAS panel in control room and accepted the fire call
	and rushed to canteen and gave a call on his walkie talkie set that the two big pans
04:12	full of edible oil used for deep fring caught fire. It was an liquid fire. On receiving his call by all. Security officer Satish Gode and Brahbakar Japye rushed.
04.12	On receiving his call by all, Security officer Satish Gode and Prabhakar Janye rushed
	to the spot to assess the fire. Seeing the gravity of fire security officer Prabhakar

	Janye announced fire emergency and ordered all firefighting teams to activate and rush to the place of fire to put it off.
04:12	Meanwhile both Sup.Sharma and Security officer Prabhakar Janye lifted nearby ABC fire extinguishers and tried to put off the fire.
04:13	Team A rushed to the spot with some more fire extinguishers and tried to put off the fire
04:14	All four lifts were brought down to 1st flr vacated and switched off by M 1 guard
04:15	Security Officer Satish Gode rushed to 'Emergency Control Room' at ground floor and made an announcement on PA system of 'Mock Drill' and subsequently outbreak of a fire at canteen kitchen and alerted all occupants of the building.
04:17	Team B also rushed behind M block building to fight the fire from rear side of kitchen.
04:20	Sec offr P M Janye reported spreading up of fire.
04:23	Sec Sup Sunil Kamble reached rear gate of canteen kitchen and observed that the door is locked and two canteen boys are trapped between fire and rear gate and having no escape route from the front. He immediately reported this to control room.
04:24	Sec Offr Satish Gode ordered to break open the lock and to enter into the room.
04:25	Sup Kamble broke open the lock and team B entered into the kitchen.
04:26	Control room activated team C and asked them to rescue the trapped persons.
04:28	Sup Bagwe with his team C and rescued both the trapped persons who sustained 10% burn injury.
04:30	Sec Offr Janye informed control room that fire is not under control with fire extinguishers and they have to switch over to fire Hydrants.
04:32	Control room gave clearance for use of hydrants and asked Nitin to call fire brigade and topsline ambulance as well.
04:33	Security Asst. Nitin from team B called fire brigade and Topsline Ambulance.
04:35	Smoke from the fire reached upto 3 rd flr and choked all three floors.
04:37	Announcement made on PA system asking occupants to leave the floor and proceed to VIT through 3 rd & 4 th flr exits.
04:40	Team A & B connected fire hoses to the hydrant points. Team B started fire engines at fire pump room.
04:43	Control room asked status of fire to both the teams.
04:45	Both the team reported no improvements in status of fire.
04:47	Intense dark smoke started engulfing 2 nd , 3rd & 4 th floor.
04:48	In view of this control room announced evacuation of the building.
04:50	Occupants' upto 3 rd flr were asked to come down to ground floor assembly area (atrium) and 4 th flr and above occupants asked to proceed to refuge area on 6 th flr as they could not come down.
04:51	Security Asst. Nitin from team B Informed Fire brigade arrived.
04:51	He also informed 1252 Topsline arrived.
04:52	Control room informed Team B to assist fire brigade in connecting hoses.
04:53	Control room also asked Team C to take the patients to ambulance.
04:54	Status of Fire – not under control – Team A / B



04:55	Head count taken at assembly point. One faculty member found missing from 3 rd flr.
04:57	Control room sent team c to check up for the person and rescue if required.
05:00	Team C Bagwe informed the person found on 4 th flr in unconscious state.
05:05	Team C rescued the person to ground floor and handed over to ambulance.
05:06	6 th floor guard reported congestion due to smoke.
05:06	Control room ordered them to proceed to terrace.
05:08	Sec offr P M Janye reported through fire brigade personnel that fire is under
	control.
05:09	Fire was completely put off.
05:10	Ambulance took all the three patients to hospital.
05:10	Control room ordered team A to undertake salvage operation.
05:10	Control room announced fire emergency over and called off.
05:10	All staff members were told to proceed to their work place and resume work.


















Mentoring
