
Marathi Vangmay Mandal


E-cell Podcast ep.05


E-cell


Data Analytics workshop




VMOL, CMA dept.


Investor Awareness Program


Financial Markets

Financial Markets


A value-added course on "Risk Management through Financial Derivatives" was organized for BFM students between July 21 and 27, 3:30 to 4:30 pm.

Derivatives are most frequently traded in order to hedge (reduce risk). Derivatives can be used in a variety of ways: to hedge a position, to speculate on the future price movement of an asset, or to give leverage.

This course provided insight on concept of Financial Derivative, types of derivative, its role in Risk Management, concept of Forward Futures and Options, Trading Strategies with the help of Futures and Options, Pay-off Charts, Concept of Hedging.

25 students participated in the value-added course.



Enactus




TY Sem V Induction


Sound Editing
