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

Hobby Club



Research Mindedness


FYPQAC

Research Methodology in social science



•Types and topics of projects that the BMS (Finance, HR, and Marketing) and BFM students can select was also discussed.



During the seminar Rahul Devdhar, Program Coordinator, VIIE, explained that Vidyalankar Institute for International Education (VIIE) is a branch of VSIT that provides opportunities for students to study abroad with proper guidance throughout the course. The partner universities are from countries like USA, Canada, Australia and New Zealand. The Bachelors program is of 2+2/1.5+2-year scheme whereas the Master's program is of 1+1year scheme. VIIE was established in 2002 with a till date success rate of 100% in student visa as well as the placements and 500+ students who passed out with flying colours. During the BMS student's session, he highlighted the programmes available to students through VSIT/VIIE for pursuing offline studies in abroad in various fields such as Finance, Marketing etc. He also gave light on the overall fee structure and scholarships. During the BA MMC session, students were informed about VIIE program offered by VSIT to aspirants who are interested to broaden their horizon in regard to studying abroad and acquiring a degree from top renowned colleges abroad. 


Synopsis Presentation Round 3

It was conducted by Mr. Laxmikant Manchekar and Ms. Amraja Shivkar between September 21 and 24, 1 pm to 2:30 pm.


Panel Discussion



VAC - Python


Software Development Cluster


DM Bridge Course

72 students attended the session.






NBFC: The future of India






Bridge Course on Basic Accounting Concepts and Techniques


Spoken Tutorial


Video-making Session

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SYBMS Induction


An Induction session was arranged for SYBMS on November 23 at 12:30 pm to make the students aware of their programme in terms of both academic and professional options available after completing the semesters.

57 students participated in the bridge course.






Redesigning of Marketing Strategies
